# Our opening hours / vacations

The opening hours in the after-school care center are daily from **11:00 am to 17:30 pm**.

Within these opening hours, you choose the actual attendance time of your child and inform us about it.

During the **Christmas and Easter holidays** there we provide a substitute facility in the immediate vicinity.

During the **summer holidays** a needs assessment decides whether we can open our facility ourselves.

From experience in recent years we had open 1 group in the first 4 vacation weeks.  
5th - 8th vacation week choose an alternative facility and  
in the 9th vacation week all facilities are closed.



# Care costs

## Discounts

Depending on the income of the family and regarding the multiple child rule, you can apply for a reduction:

- At the service point in the districts of the city of Graz.
- And possibly for state subsidies

Children living away from home (without main residence in Graz) are full payers, currently for 2022/23 this is € 285,21.

## Additional costs:

**Material contribution:** 5 € monthly

**Snack contribution:** 20 € per Semester (Sept. – Jän.) / (Feb—Jun.)

We provide a varried snack buffet.

# 4 groups - open working

We work in the **open system**.  
The children are organizationally divided into  
4 color groups:



Through our open work  
a free space is created,  
in which they can use all the rooms.  
On the basis of our **magnet board** it is evident,  
in which area the child is currently occupied.



# Open work for the child means:

- ✓ Being able to organize time individually, "I would like to ... We need ..."
- ✓ Clear rules, daily routines and structure allow decision-making and choices
- ✓ Rooms and areas can be visited at will and desire
- ✓ Experience multiple caregivers and relationship opportunities (with individual focuses, abilities and personalities)

# Lunch buffet

**Lunch buffet:** Lunch is served in the dining room from 12 - 14 o'clock in the dining room with individual timing. We pay attention to a relaxed and cozy atmosphere.

Lunch is provided by the kitchen in Graz ("cook and chill" - system), there are two menus to choose from, including a vegetarian one.



# Snack buffet

## Snack buffet in the afternoon:

You do not have to bring a snack. We organize this with your monthly contribution. We pay attention to a fresh, varied and healthy snack. On warm days we enjoy the food on the terrace, including fresh herbs and vegetable self-made from the Naschgarden.

**Fruit and drinking water** are available for free consumption at any time.







# Location consolidation of kindergarten and after-school-care



Through a common management  
a common thread runs through the  
**educational landscape for  
3 to 15 year olds.**

Through **networked work** in the  
large team, the  
**exchange of resources**  
creates a valuable **"WE" feeling.**

It enables parents to plan long term,  
and when changing facilities, the  
familiar management is available as  
a contact person.

It simplifies the contact of both  
facilities with parents and **siblings.**



# Cooperation between kindergarten and after-school-care



This results in a **pedagogy of diversity** (e.g. open groups, cross-age family groups, holistic pedagogical methods adapted to the child's stage of development).

The Nippelgasse kindergarten and after-school care center are intended to be a house of encounter where children, parents and staff feel **warmly welcomed** and comfortable.


