

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON REGISTERING FOR THE VACCINATION AND ON THE VACCINATION ITSELF

How much does the vaccination cost?

The vaccination is free of charge for you.

Where can I find further medical information or ask questions?

General information can be obtained at www.sozialministerium.at or from the hotline of the Austrian Agency for Health and Food Safety (AGES) on 0800/555 621. Your GP will also undoubtedly be pleased to answer individual questions.

You will receive an informed consent form before your vaccination appointment. You can have a consultation with a doctor at the vaccination centre.

Which data are required during registration?

In the attached questionnaire you will find information about data that we require for your registration for the vaccination. Please prepare these data for your registration.

The province of Styria requires your consent to the further use and processing of your data. Data will only be processed pursuant to the valid data privacy provisions. Details on this can be found in the attached data privacy notice.

Who can help me with registration?

You can of course ask a person you trust to assist you during registration. If the registration for the vaccination is the responsibility of a person authorised by you to manage your affairs or of a legal guardian, the registration for the vaccination is to be agreed with this person or carried out by him or her.

What can I do if all lines for registering by telephone are busy?

Please try again a few minutes later. We are expecting a large number of calls and will strive to record your registrations as quickly as possible. The time of your call or your registration is not decisive for your vaccination appointment.

Please only register for the vaccination if you are eligible to do so. Currently, all people over 80 with their main place of residence in Graz are eligible.

Is registration also necessary if I am already registered with my GP for the vaccination?

Yes, please register nevertheless. We can only guarantee the vaccine for you if you register.

When and where will my vaccination take place?

Unfortunately, it may be some time before you are vaccinated. As soon as the vaccine is available, you will be contacted again and will receive all the necessary information regarding the time and place of the vaccine.

The vaccinations will be given at municipal vaccination centres and at GP surgeries.

I am not mobile and can therefore not come to the vaccination centre.

Should I still register?

Yes, please register with us nevertheless. You will be informed separately about a possible vaccination appointment at home.
